What will you learn from attending the workshop:

The Information & Planning Workshop Series 2011 is an opportunity for injury prevention practitioners, agencies, community groups, volunteer services and organisations to receive up-to-date information, data and new resources on the new Campaign themes.

Attendees are invited to network across sectors, engage in planning activities, and develop joint strategies for action in their local community to prevent driveway run over and home injuries.

- Health service providers: DHB, Whanau Ora providers Well Child providers, Plunket, Tamariki Ora and Karitane nurses, Public Health Units, family support services, maternity services, district nurses.
- Council, Road Safety Coordinators, Community leaders and decision makers.
- Maori providers & Pacific Peoples providers.
- Refugee and new migrant services: Refugees As Survivors, Asian Network.
- Social support services: Family/ whanau and community services such as Family Start, REAP, Community Links, WINZ.
- Housing New Zealand, those working in rental agencies.
- Early childhood educators: home based (HIPPY, PAFT, Barnardos) and learning centres such as pre-school staff including kindergartens, Te Kohanga Reo, Pacific language nests, play groups and play centre facilitators.
- Injury prevention practitioners: local government safety advisors, community safety advisers, car restraint technicians, ACC.
- Adult education services: parent educators, workplace educators.
- Police: Community policing teams, Police Education Officers, Serious Crash Unit.
- Volunteer services: Plunket, Fire Service, Age Concern
- Anyone with an interest in child safety.
